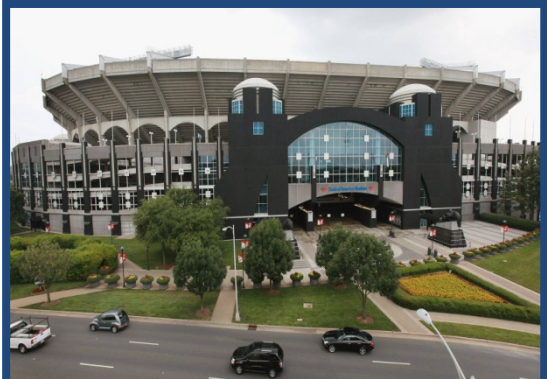

CHARLOTTE CITY TOUR



Charlotte City Tour - German settlers, faithful to both England and Germany, arrived in 1755. They named the town Charlotte Town in honor of German-born Queen Charlotte, the wife of England's King George III. The county in which Charlotte resides adopted the name of the queen's birthplace—Mecklenburg. The first gold rush in the United States occurred in 1799 when a 17-pound nugget was found near Charlotte. Present-day Charlotte is the second largest financial center in the United States, behind New York City. Bank of America is headquartered here. Wells Fargo Bank has its East Coast operations center in Charlotte. Learn about the early history of Charlotte plus what makes present-day Charlotte such a vibrant and exciting city.

OLDE MECKLENBURG BREWERY TOUR AND BEER TASTING



Olde Mecklenburg Brewery (OMB) is the oldest and largest brewery in Charlotte. Your visit includes a tour of the brewery where you are given a unique insight into the authentic ingredients and time-honored brewing process of the classic German-style beers at OMB. OMB adheres to the strict world-famous "Reinheitsgebot" beer purity law of 1516 that ensures all natural beers with no artificial chemicals, preservatives, or additives. During the tour you will be able to touch and taste the barley malt, smell the Bavarian noble hops and learn how the beer is brewed, fermented and packaged using traditional methods.

After the tour, enjoy a 4-oz. sampling of four different OMB beers. After sampling these beers, sit back, relax and enjoy one 16-oz. mug of your favorite OMB beer. Additional mugs of beer are available for purchase.

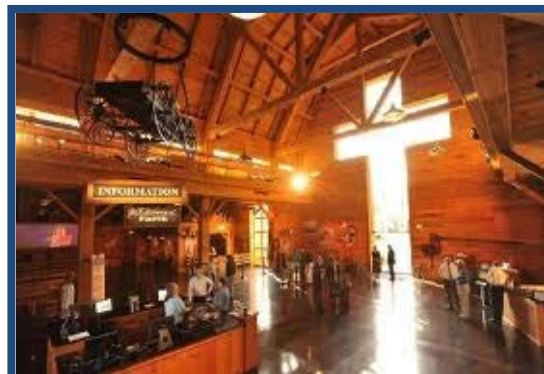

THE BILLY GRAHAM LIBRARY

NASCAR HALL OF FAME



The world-famous NASCAR Hall of Fame is across the street from the Convention Center and is open seven days a week from 10:00am to 6:00pm. Advance reservations are **NOT** needed; just visit the Hall of Fame at your leisure.

Covering more than five acres, the state-of-the-art NASCAR Hall of Fame pays tribute to NASCAR heroes past and present plus the history of auto racing. A banked ramp simulates various racetracks while Glory Road showcases 18 historic cars as well as 40 current and historic tracks. Various degrees of banking at racetracks are depicted, including the 33-degree incline at the Talladega Superspeedway. Interactive exhibits allow visitors to compete against others in pit crew challenges such as jacking up a car and changing a tire.

Visitors can walk through a full-size NASCAR Sprint Cup hauler. There are outstanding displays of racing suits, trophies and heirlooms and memorabilia from the families of racing legends.

And what a deal we have for The American Legion. The regular adult admission price is \$19.95. However, show your American Legion name badge at the NASCAR Hall of Fame Box Office and your admission ticket is only \$10.00. And as an added bonus, this ticket is valid for FIVE consecutive days. You will need to show a picture ID when you use the ticket.
