

# *The William & Mary* **VETERANS WRITING PROJECT**

We're glad you're attending the **William & Mary Veterans Writing Project** on Saturday, November 8<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. In the paragraphs below, we've tried to answer many of the questions we anticipate you'll have concerning logistics for the seminar. Please read through completely because we ask you to respond to some questions. To begin with, this is a long, intense weekend of seminars. You'll spend most of it sitting in a chair. Dress comfortably. We look forward to meeting. Please don't hesitate to ask specific questions if we've left something out.

## **VENUE**

We'll meet in the **Mason School of Business** (101 Ukrop Way), which is on the Jamestown Road side of the William & Mary campus in Williamsburg, VA. When you enter the building, there will be a sign in table in front of the statue of Pierre L'Enfant. From there, you will be directed to **room 1013**, which is in the back-right portion of the building.

## **TIME**

We run the seminars between 9 am and 5 pm on both Saturday and Sunday. Please try to arrive by **8:45 am** on Saturday.

## **MATERIALS**

We provide you with a copy of our curriculum, *Writing War: A Guide to Telling Your Own Story*. You're responsible for anything you want to use to take notes (laptop or notepad is fine).

## **FOOD**

We provide coffee in the morning and lunches on both Saturday and Sunday. The fare is usually sandwiches and chips. If you have special dietary needs, please let us know and we will accommodate accordingly.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

**From Richmond Metro/Washington, D.C. area and points north**

Get on I-64 East toward Williamsburg/Norfolk. Take Exit 234 (for VA-199 South/VA-646). Continue on VA-199 South for about eight miles to John Tyler Highway/VA-5. Turn left and stay on John Tyler Highway/VA-5. Turn left at Jamestown Road, Route 31, for about a mile, to Ukrop Way. Turn left at Ukrop Way and Miller Hall is the first building on your left.

**From Norfolk/Virginia Beach area and points south**

Get on I-64 West toward Williamsburg/Richmond. Take Exit 242A (VA-199) towards Jamestown/Williamsburg. Continue about 5.5 miles, then turn right on Jamestown Road, Route 31. Drive another mile to Ukrop Way. Turn left at Ukrop Way and Miller Hall is the first building on your left.

## **PARKING**

Parking is free on campus on the weekends. Directly across from the Mason School of Business is a large parking lot that we encourage you to use.
