Access for Convention Center

Time for access to convention building: 6:00AM
Time for access to convention floor: 7:00AM
Time Convention Center closes: One hour after last event

If you are attending a meeting/function at the **Millennium**, use any house or guest room telephone and dial “0” to report an emergency. The operator will dispatch Fire Rescue to your location and the Manager on Duty will be notified immediately to respond. If attendees would like to program their cell phones for emergency situations within the Millennium, please list (513) 352-2100 as the number for security.

If you are attending a meeting/function at the **Hyatt Regency Cincinnati**, use any house telephone and dial “55” to report an emergency. The operator will dispatch emergency assistance to your location. If attendees would like to program their cell phones for emergency situations within the Hotel, please list (513) 579-1234 as the number for security.

If you are attending a meeting/function at the **Hilton Cincinnati Netherland Plaza Hotel**, use any house telephone and dial “7777” to report an emergency. The operator will dispatch emergency assistance to your location. If attendees would like to program their cell phones for emergency situations within the Hilton Cincinnati Netherland Plaza Hotel, please list (513) 421-9100 and have the Hotel Operator radio for security assistance.
